MANCHESTER TOWNSHIP BOARD MINUTES  
PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing on the proposed General Fund and Special Fund budgets was held on June 26, 2007 at the township hall. The purpose of hearing was to take public comment on the proposed General Fund and Special Fund budgets and to take public comment on the operating tax millage rate.

Supervisor Mann called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. Board members present: Mann, Bechtel, Huber, Widmayer, Kolon and Schmitt. Absent: Macomber. No others in attendance.

Revenues and expenditures for the General Fund budget for fiscal year 2007-08 were reviewed and discussed. All Special fund budgets for fiscal year 2007-08 were also reviewed.
